1. Chapter 3 Discussion

- Christi told the group of the current issues with the modeling software, Predict. In calculating loading, should we use the higher or lower MAF? The group discussed this topic at length. Lajuanda suggested one important thing to remember is whichever you choose, remain consistent throughout the process. Steve commented that the guidebook could use more guidance on models and actual loads. Christi noted that the modeling was very time consuming.
- The group decided to make a list of BMPs, then refine the list, look at it per sub-basin, put information back into model to come up with target loading. Then prioritize the BMPs taking into consideration local knowledge, feasibility, and water quality impact

2. Roundtable Planning Session

- The group discussed the best way to present the project to the public.
